



62nd ANNUAL OPEN EXHIBITION AND COMPETITIONS 2011

The Exhibition will be held at St. Paul's Church Hall, Ramsey from Thursday 28th July until Saturday 6th August. Opening times are from 10:00am to 6:30pm daily except on Sunday 31st July which are 2:00pm to 6:00pm. The Exhibition will close on Saturday 6th August at 4.00pm. (Last Entry 3.15pm.)

EXHIBITION RULES

1. Members may submit up to three exhibits. (This number does NOT include the miniature competition entry) The committee reserves the right to save space, if necessary, by eliminating the last entry on the form. Non-members are restricted to two entries, both of which must be for sale. (This number does not include a miniature competition entry).
2. Hanging fee Non-members £4 per entry. (Members £1 per entry).
3. A commission of 12.5% will be levied on all sales.
4. N.F.S.-one picture only may be NOT FOR SALE.
5. Any infringement of copyright will be the sole responsibility of the artist.
6. **Exhibits must be tautly corded, conventionally framed and have the enclosed label on a cord long enough to hang over the front of the picture. FRAMES AND CORDING must be secure and in good condition. Entries contravening any of these conditions will not be exhibited and the fees will not be reimbursed.**
7. Exhibits must not have been previously shown in any exhibitions or galleries.
8. **Unsold pictures MUST BE COLLECTED ON Saturday 6th August NO EARLIER than 4.30pm and NO LATER THAN 5.30pm. NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ACCEPTED FOR UNCOLLECTED EXHIBITS.**
9. Please enter details on the accompanying form (repeating IDENTICAL information on the labels) sign the completed form, which must accompany your Exhibits and be delivered to St Paul's Church Hall, Ramsey on **SATURDAY 23rd JULY, 2011 between 12.30pm and 2.30pm.**
10. Any exhibit which measures more than 3 ft wide x 3 ft high may only be exhibited with prior approval of the committee, which may require the exhibitor to be responsible for the transportation and hanging of the exhibit.
11. The committee reserves the right to exclude any exhibit.
12. The Mannin Art Group accepts no responsibility for loss or damage however occasioned.
13. Exhibits to be priced at a minimum of £35.00.
14. Entrants and competitors must be aged 18 years or over.
